

First Reading: Genesis 14:18-20

Responsorial Psalm: You are a priest forever,

a priest like Melchizedek of old

Second Reading: Corinthians 11:23-26

Gospel: Luke 9:11-17

The Eucharist is not an invention of the Church: it is a part of God's plan of salvation from the very beginning: it is prefigured in the Old Testament, seen today in the food offerings of Melchizedek, priest king of Jerusalem associated with Abraham, choose bread and wine as the offerings.
