A prophet is only despised in his own country."

A prophet's job is to open people's eyes to the reality of their situation - pointing out to them the things they would rather forget or ignore. A prophet is a sort of "national conscience", always awake to situations of injustice and always speaking out about them. A prophet is commissioned to do this by God, who sends the prophet on his mission Jesus is just such a prophet - teaching and preaching about the Kingdom of God and the best way to live. Despite the welcome his message has received elsewhere, when he comes to his hometown he is faced with rejection -such that "he was amazed at their lack of faith." It is curious is that they seem to accept his wisdom, and his miracles, but because he grew up among them they cannot accept him as a teacher from God. We should remember that it is often hardest to stand up for the truth among those who know us well.

S.P.U.C. NOTICE

Assisted Dying Bill Vote in the House of Commons Urgent Appeal: Oppose Doctor- Assisted Suicide.

Please write to your MP today, asking him/her to oppose the Assisted Dying Bill. There will be a vote in the House of Commons on 11th September 2015. It is urgent to write to MPS before 21st July as that is the last day before the summer recess. After that many MPS will be away until just before 11th September. The **Assisted Dying Bill** would allow doctors or other health professionals to provide help such as lethal drugs for dying people to commit suicide. Assisted dying gives the message to sick, disabled and elderly people that they don't have lives worth living. Vulnerable people can feel under pressure to choose death. Evidence of how this has happened in other countries where assisted dying has been legalised and other arguments against the bill are available from SPUC.
