**PSALTER WEEK 1** 

"Your liberation is near at hand."

As usual, the great Season of Advent begins, not by talking about Christmas, but about the Second Coming. We've had this theme already for the past two weeks, but there is a slight change of emphasis in the Scripture readings offered for this Sunday: here the tone is positive: it is the promise of what is to come that we contemplate. Even in the Gospel, though it talks of the dreadful signs that mark the end times, we hear of a promise - "liberation. For this we should stand erect and hold our heads high. The central theme is that we welcome the coming of a person - Jesus Christ, the promised Messiah, and this is what links this Sunday to the coming feast of his birth: we are now preparing to celebrate how he once came: may these preparations also help us to prepare for him when he comes again.

### **PSALM**

Lord, make me know your ways. Lord, teach me your paths. Make me walk in your truth, and teach me: for you are God my saviour. The Lord is good and upright. He shows the path to those who stray, he guides the humble in the right path; he teaches his way to the poor. His ways are faithfulness and love for those who keep his covenant and will. ## 8th December 2015 - 20th November 2016 YEAR OF MERCY

## Invitation to receive and proclaim God's Love and Mercy

On 8 December 2015, the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception, Pope Francis will open a Holy Year of Mercy. The Pope desires that the year "will be steeped in mercy, so that we can go out to every man and woman, bringing the goodness and tenderness of God! May the balm of mercy reach everyone, both believers and those far away, as a sign that the Kingdom of God is already present in our midst!" (Bull of Indiction 5)

As the Year of Mercy coincides with the centenary of the Archdiocese, Archbishop George has named <u>FIVE</u> churches to house a "Door of Mercy". The locations have been chosen because of their significance to the founding of the Archdiocese of Cardiff:

<u>St David's Cathedral, Cardiff</u> - Mother Church of the Archdiocese

<u>Belmont Abbey</u> - Home to the Benedictine Monks who played a significant role in re-establishing the Faith within this part of Wales and Herefordshire, and pro-cathedral of the Diocese of Newport and Menevia

<u>St. Mary's, Bridgend</u> - One of the first Benedictine foundations in the Diocese

<u>St. Mary's, Merthyr Tydfil</u> - One of the first Benedictine foundations in the Diocese

<u>St. Mary's, Newport</u> - Original Rosminian foundation and intended home for the Bishops of Newport

Works to be performed for the Jubilee Year of Mercy Indulgence
The requirements are as follows:

### For able-bodied Catholics

Make a Pilgrimage to one of the Holy Doors within your local area (diocese), or at one of the Papal Basilicas in Rome. Crossing through the Holy Door is a spiritual journey signifying "the deep desire for true conversion".

Go to Confession.

Receive the Holy Eucharist "with a reflection of mercy". Make a profession of faith.

Pray for the Pope and his intentions.

By living their trial in life in a spirit of "faith and joyful hope".

Receiving the Eucharist.

Or by attending Mass or Community Prayer "even through the various means of communication" eg. on TV, radio, Internet
