The Holy Spirit will remind you of all I have said to you.

As Eastertide unfolds, we feel the power and influence of the Spirit growing. This is the Spirit who raised Jesus from the dead, and the Spirit who brings the Church to birth at Pentecost. As we journey towards Pentecost - the climax of the Easter Season - we should be considering the presence of the Spirit in the Church today: the reconciler of disputes, the solver of problems, true inspiration for the family of God on our journey to the New Jerusalem! From this side, Pentecost is about promise: the Lord at the Last Supper promises that He and the Father will be "at home" with all who keep his words - and it is the Advocate, the Holy Spirit who will remind us of these and all his words. We believe that all Scripture is "inspired" - the word of the Spirit - so as we listen or proclaim this Sunday let us look for the fulfilment of the promise made by the Lord.

Aid the People of Ukraine

Pope Francis's has made an appeal to raise funds to aid the people of Ukraine who have suffered two years of ongoing conflict. In the interview, a high ranking leader of Ukraine's Greek Catholic Church Bishop Gudziak says, "officially, ten thousand people have been killed" since the conflict erupted between government forces and pro-Russian separatists two years ago. "Tens of thousands have been maimed or injured: without legs, without arms, without eyes – paralyzed. There are hundreds of thousands of people with post-traumatic shock and 2.5 million people had to leave their homes because five million people were directly affected by the war," he adds. He goes on to say that half a million people have left Ukraine and two million are internally displaced persons.

It is always important to help those who are poor and suffering. And this collection will do that, and of course, asking everybody to pray is very important because we know that prayer moves mountains.
