St Richard Gwyn a layman and school-teacher, hung, drawn and quartered on October 17, 1584 St John Jones hung, drawn, and quartered after two year's

imprisonment and torture on July 12, 1598 St John Roberts executed at Tyburn on December 10, 1610 St Philip Evans and St John Lloyd both executed in connection with the fake Popish Plot on July 22, 1679 St David Lewis The Last Welsh Martyr. Executed on August 27, 1679
