Day for Life is the day in the Church's year dedicated to raising awareness about the meaning and value of human life at every stage and in every condition. On 24th June, there will be a second collection in the parish to support Day for Life. Proceeds of the collection will go to a full range of work that supports life in all its forms. This includes the Anscombe Bioethics Centre and other Church supported life activities. In the UK alone, it is estimated that every year there are over 13,000 victims of trafficking.
