SHARE THE JOURNEY: War, persecution, natural disaster and poverty force millions of people from their homes. Share the Journey is a global campaign launched by Pope Francis and is "a unique opportunity" for Catholics to put pressure on governments to respond to the huge levels of global migration around the world. It highlights the need to build relationships between migrants, refugees and local communities. At the end of 2018 the United Nations will agree two new agreements which will shape how countries respond to migrants and refugees for years to come.

How can you help to make a difference? We are asking our parishes, schools and youth groups to support the campaign by joining our "walk around the world" and to organise a walk in your parish or school community: to step up and step out in solidarity with people who are displaced. You can walk around the church building, 100 yards, 1 mile or 100 miles. It's up to you. We're hoping that walking together as a parish will provide an opportunity to reflect on refugee stories, to talk, to pray and to put your faith into action and demonstrate how much it matters to all of us, that refugees and migrants are treated with dignity and respect.
