CAFOD Cyclone Idai Emergency Appeal

The scale of the crisis is such that the Disaster Emergency Committee, of which CAFOD is a member, has launched a fullscale humanitarian appeal. CAFOD's Director, Christine Allen, said "The more we see and hear of the destruction caused by Cyclone Idai, the more shocking is the devastating impact on the lives of children, women and men. Reports from the ground tell us of entire villages submerged and whole families missing. "But there are still lives to be saved and communities who need our help. We cannot waste any time reaching those in urgent need. "We've already seen how the Catholic community has responded, here in England and Wales and through our global church network. CAFOD has made an initial £100,000 pledge for Mozambique and £50,000 for Zimbabwe, but much more will be needed as the disaster unfolds. "This money will help families who have lost everything to survive the coming days. Knowing they are not alone will give them hope." We are so thankful for your support of our recent Family Fast Day, which we rely on for our planned projects over the next year around the world. We don't make this request lightly, but the situation is so urgent, we are asking, if possible, a second collection be taken to help us support these vulnerable families.
