(203) What is Confirmation?

Confirmation is the Sacrament that completes Baptism; in it the gift of the Holy Spirit is bestowed upon us. Anyone who freely decides to live as God's child and asks for God's Spirit under the signs of the imposition of hands and anointing with *Chrism* receives strength to witness to God's love and might in word and deed. He is now a full-fledged, responsible member of the Catholic Church.

Chrism is an ointment made out of a mixture of olive oil and balsam. It is consecrated at the Chrism Mass by the bishop, so it can be used in Baptism, Confirmation, priestly and episcopal ordination, and also the consecration of altars and bells. Oil is a symbol of joy, strength, and health
