**Trussell Trust Foodbank Collection
Holiday Hunger**

Every summer, food banks in the Trussell Trust's network report an increase in demand for emergency food for children over the summer holidays due to the extra financial pressure put on families who rely on free school meals during term time. This high demand often causes many food banks to distribute more food than is donated, which leaves them short of food supplies. Between April 2018 and March 2019, 1.6 million emergency food parcels were distributed which is a 19% rise year on year and it is expected that this trend will continue into the summer. **The next collection is on 3/4th August**
