St Ignatius of Loyola, Priest, Religious

St Ignatius (1491-1556) was born into a noble family at Loyola (Spain). He was injured at the battle of Pamplana (1521) and experienced a conversion during his convalescence. He went on to write the Spiritual Exercises, study theology at Paris and, with his companions, found the Society of Jesus. The Jesuits have had a huge impact on the reform of the Church, the education of the young and the preaching of the Gospel to every corner of the world

St Alphonsus Liguori, Bishop & Doctor

St Alphonsus Liguori (1696-1787) was born in Naples (Italy) and became a priest after training as a lawyer. He founded the Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer (Redemptorists), which specialised in preaching missions, and in 1762 was appointed Bishop of Sant' Agata dei Goti. He faced much physical suffering and division within his Order. His numerous writings, especially on moral theology, earned him the title of Doctor of the Church
