<u>The Dedication of the Basilica of</u> <u>St Mary Major</u>

In 431 the Council of Ephesus declared the Blessed Virgin to be the "Mother of God" (Theotokos) and shortly afterwards Pope Sixtus III dedicated the restored Basilica of St Mary Major in Rome in her honour. According to tradition its location had originally been indicated by a miraculous shower of snow on 5th August, in the middle of the Roman summer, hence the title "Our Lady of the Snows". The basilica is considered the most important church dedicated to the Blessed Virgin Mary and the festival of its dedication renews our link with Rome.
