### *From the Bishops of England and Wales*

We invite all Catholics in England and Wales to respond in prayer and action to the urgent climate change issues that we all face. This is a Novena of reading and prayers drawn from the Bible and recent Papal teaching. Between Ascension and Pentecost, the Scriptures tell us: *"All these with one accord were devoting themselves to prayer together with the women and Mary the mother of Jesus, and his brothers..."* (Acts 1:14) while they awaited to be *"clothed with power from on high."* (Luke 24:49).

We are invited to pray these nine days reflecting on the account of creation in the book of Genesis. Both Masses will be live streamed from Our Lady's.

### *World Communications Day*

On World Communications Day, we take up the command of Jesus to preach the Good News of the Gospel to the whole world. Vital to this is good communication - through our websites, publications and social media channels. The Bishops' Conference works hard to forge positive relationships with media outlets to communicate news relating to every aspect of the life of the Catholic Church and her people.

The theme for the 2021 World Day of Social Communications, chosen by Pope Francis, echoes the words of the Apostle Philip, recognising that authentic communication leads to "encountering people as and where they are". Taken from the Bible, John 1: 46, the words "Come and see" are central to the Gospel. Before the Gospel is proclaimed, prior to words, there are "looks, testimonies, experiences, encounters and closeness. In a word – life." Pope Francis provides the subtitle: "Communicating, encountering people as and where they are". We are asked by the Bishops of England and Wales to contribute to help spread the Good News: collection baskets are in the porches.

**7<sup>TH</sup> SUNDAY OF EASTERTIDE**

Today we are asked to pray for Rev Canon Barry English and parishioners of Saint Benedict, Merthyr Vale.



Through prayer a new incarnation of the Word takes place. And we are the “tabernacles” where the words of God want to be welcomed and preserved, so that they may visit the world. This is why we must approach the Bible



without ulterior motives, without exploiting it. The believer does not turn to the Holy Scriptures to support his or her own philosophical and moral view, but because he or she hopes for an encounter; the believer knows that those words were written in the Holy Spirit, and that therefore in that same Spirit they must be welcomed and understood, so that the encounter can occur. *That they may be one like us!*

Jesus is about to leave them, and knows that they are not in a fit condition, so will need the Father's help in the face of what is to happen in the future. Jesus sums up his care for the disciples, acknowledging that one has been lost, but through that one's deliberate choice. Jesus asks the Father to make the disciples "holy", that is, that they identify themselves with God's purpose, just as Jesus did. His final act of holiness will be to give himself completely to God's will, and in this will reveal to them the love of the Father. Holiness is rooted in the unity of the disciples with the Father, and it is on the basis of this that Jesus is sending them out to continue his work of revealing God to human beings.
