From Fr. Daniel...

The COVID-19 pandemic has had consequences far beyond the mere physical. While the physical suffering is now being aided through the reception of the vaccine, and life seems to be slipping to a more 'normal' rhythm, the same cannot be said about the spiritual and psychological well-being of individuals. The pandemic has left many people with significant wounds, through: significant changes to daily living, feeling of loneliness and isolation, job loss, financial difficulty, the inability to grieve the loss of a loved one; the list can go on.

As Catholics, we believe fundamentally in the dignity of the whole human person - physical, spiritual, psychological (emotional). These components, making up the human person, are fundamentally connected, and so need to be cared for together; one aspect profoundly affects the other. The experience of loneliness and isolation, then, is not only an emotional trauma, but also a spiritual one. As a parish community, our commitment to discipleship means allowing the Lord's healing hand to be extended through our actions, so that these wounds have the opportunity of healing. Individuals within our parish, as well as organisations such as the SVP and UCM, work tirelessly in this endeavour. From visiting parishioners over these last few months, I know that the formation of the *Tuesday Club*, for example, will provide an oasis for many within our community who themselves feel isolated and alone. The same is true with the parish coffee mornings. There may be initiatives which you have thought about; don't be afraid to share them.
