On Friday, 22<sup>nd</sup> October, the 'Assisted Dying Bill' is having its second reading in the House of Lords. If legalised, this bill will allow a terminally ill adult with less than six months to live to be assisted in committing suicide.

In light of this bill, we are being asked to:

1. **PRAY** that the Bill will be defeated.
2. **WRITE** to the Peers from your personal experience and share stories which will argue for the reasons for opposing the Bill as well as narrate the importance of precious time during the final stages of life.
3. **SHARE** information about the Bill via social media and other means to bring this into the open.
