The Easter Triduum 2022

The Catechism of the Catholic Church describes the Easter Triduum in the following way: "... *Easter is not simply one feast among others, but the "Feast of feasts," the "Solemnity of solemnities," just as the Eucharist is the "Sacrament of sacraments" (the Great Sacrament)"*

The schedule for the Sacred Triduum within the parish is as follows (OLA – Our Lady's; SD – St. David's):

7:00pm – Mass of the Lord's Supper (OLA)
Followed by: Watching with the Lord until 10:00pm
10:00pm – Night Prayer at the Altar of Repose

Good Friday

9:30am – Office of Readings & Morning Prayer (SD)
3:00pm – The Solemn Passion of the Lord (OLA)
7:00pm – The Stations of the Cross (SD)

Holy Saturday

9:30am – Office of Readings & Morning Prayer (SD)
8:00pm – The Easter Vigil (OLA)
Including Baptisms & Reception into Full Communion

Easter Sunday

9:30am – Holy Mass (OLA)
11:15am Holy Mass (SD)
