Since things have returned to 'normal', I have continued to celebrate this Mass. On average, we welcome between twenty and thirty people to the 6:30pm Mass. After prayer and discernment, and after speaking with Canon Nick James, our Dean, and the 6:30pm Mass community, I have decided to suspend this Mass. As you can often see in the weekly schedule opposite, Saturdays are often very busy days, and this is not something which I can sustain by myself for the long term. The last 6:30pm Vigil Mass to be celebrated will be next Saturday, 29th April. I am very grateful to the parishioners who have supported this Mass, and have provided welcome to parishioners and visitors, as well as supported through the various ministries.
