# From Fr. Daniel

On Monday I begin my annual retreat. A priest is required to spend time on retreat. If we look at Jesus Himself, our model, He spends time away from His flock; look at the time He spent before the beginning of His public ministry (Cf. Luke 4: 1-3). Priests are called by God to be reservoirs of grace. One of my favourite spiritual books, *The Soul of the Apostolate*, reflects that, in order for a priest to give himself to others, he must be filled with grace. The author reflects: "If you are wise, you will be reservoirs and not channels ... The channels let the water flow away, and do not retain a drop. But the reservoir is first filled, and then, without emptying itself, pours out its overflow, which is ever renewed over the fields which it waters". In the busyness of parish life, there is a real risk of running on empty. The annual retreat is the primary way in which this reservoir is able to be refilled.

Please be assured of my prayers during this coming week.
