# <u>Process of Union of the Diocese of Menevia and</u> <u>Archdiocese of Cardiff</u>

In December 2023, Archbishop Mark informed us via newsletter and video about the possible unification of the Dioceses of Cardiff and Menevia. In January, we published details of the "Open Listening" sessions' dates and locations. Over the following months, he travelled across both dioceses to gather people's views on the proposed unification and the church in general. A total of 605 people, including clergy and laity, attended the 42 meetings. The Archbishop has now submitted his dossier to the Nuncio, who will relay it to the Holy See.

Here is an update from Archbishop Mark:

You will all be aware that the process in terms of meetings – 42 in total – was completed at the end of May. I spent the past few weeks reviewing the material and preparing my own "Votum" (letter) to the Holy Father to accompany the dossier. I am very grateful to all who took part in the Listening Process, and engaged in the "conversations in the Spirit" at the open meetings. Thank you, too, to those who wrote letters. I believe that the process to date was fruitful, not only in gathering views on the proposed unification, but also in highlighting areas of focus for us in the coming years, in order to continue our journey along the Synodal Way and making this very much mission-focussed.

I have now submitted several copies of the dossier to the Nuncio for him to relay to the Holy See. Apart from personal letters to me, we will release the full dossier in September. I want to leave a few months to ensure that this has arrived with the Holy Father, before doing so, which I am sure you understand. However, I do share with you, the summary statistics on the straw polling that was taken about unification, together with a synopsis of the themes that emerged through the 'conversations in the Spirit' with clergy, religious and lay faithful.

### Parish Prayer

Come Holy Spirit, fill our hearts with wisdom, love and courage, make us more like Christ in our works and actions.

Bless the work of your Church. Renew us all in the desire to make Christ known and loved in the world today. Bless the work of our Parish. Guide all that we do so that our church is a place of mercy and service for all who are seeking you. Deepen our love for the Presence of Christ in the Eucharist and guide us in prayer and action as we journey towards Discipleship to become the Church you are calling us to be. We ask this through Jesus Christ, our Lord. Amen.

In regard to these themes, I am currently putting together a "Think tank for Mission" – a group of laity, religious and clergy – to explore a Vision for Mission for us, following a synodal path. This will be to assist us all, whether as a unified diocese, or as working more closely as two dioceses, depending on what the Holy See decides. We await that decision, hopefully, sometime in the Autumn.

In the meantime, I ask you to continue to pray for all in our two Dioceses so that we may continue to explore how best to 'look outwards' in mission to those who do not believe and to those who are in need. We pray too, for the work of the Holy See, in assisting and guiding Dioceses in these important and sensitive discernments. Please pray for me, too.
